***Schedule for Memorial Services & Parade***

In honor of the 18 Closter residents who gave the ultimate sacrifice in World War I, World War II and Vietnam, as well as those residents who are currently serving, the 2017 Memorial Day schedule of events is as follows:

- 8:30 a.m. Leroy S. Mead Post 111, American Legion Memorial Service**  
Veterans Monument Park, Herbert Avenue & Closter Dock Rd.
- 9:00 a.m. Closter Fire Department Service**  
100 Ruckman Road
- 10:00 a.m. Memorial Day Parade**  
9:30 a.m. assembly in the St. Mary's Church parking area  
Parade steps off at 10:00 a.m.

**Parade Route:** from St. Mary's parking lot (Legion Place) to High St. heading east. Bears left onto Closter Dock Rd, past the Closter Borough Hall; proceeds west on Closter Dock Rd. towards Harrington Avenue. Parade concludes at Veteran's Memorial Park.

The Memorial Day Ceremony, which begins immediately following the conclusion of the parade, is held on the north side of Veteran's Memorial Park. *All parade participants and spectators* are invited to the Closter Elks Lodge for free refreshments at the conclusion of the ceremony.
